

**Response to the observation stemming from the Health Canada inspection

OBSERVATION AND RESPONSE

ANTICOAGULANT SOLUTION – C.04.411

- 1. There was no evidence that the anticoagulant solution used for collecting human plasma by aphaeresis (source plasma) had obtained a drug identification number (DIN) from Health Canada.**

Response:

The supplier, Haemonetics, was contacted and informed about this requirement and they confirmed that a request for a DIN will be sent to Health Canada in January 2010 for the anticoagulant solution used by Héma-Québec.
