

A few SELECTION CRITERIA



To read before you register

CRITERIA	CAN I GIVE BLOOD?
ACUPUNCTURE	Only if done with single-use needles. OTHERWISE, you must wait 3 months.
AGE	If you are 18 years old and older.
ALLERGIES	If you feel well, even if you were given an allergy injection.
BODY PIERCING/TATTOOS	If done over 3 months ago.
CANCER	 If it is a skin cancer (basal or squamous cell carcinoma) or a uterine cervical cancer in situ, as long as it has been successfully treated. For any other type of cancer: consult with Héma-Québec staff.
CHILDBIRTH BREASTFEEDING PREGNANCY	 If birth occurred more than 6 months ago. If you are breastfeeding, provided birth occurred more than 6 months ago. If you are pregnant.
CHOLESTEROL	No restrictions.
COLD	If you feel well and do not have any fever.
DENTIST	 If whitening or impression. The day after a filling (restoration), cleaning or orthodontics. 3 days after an extraction, surgery, root canal, crown, root planing, gum autograft or implant.
DIABETES	If resolved or controlled by diet or oral medication. IF TREATED WITH INSULINE: consult with Héma-Québec staff.
DRUGS	If intravenous, even once.
ELECTROLYSIS	Only if done with single-use or personal use needles. OTHERWISE, you must wait 3 months.
HIGH-RISK SEXUAL BEHAVIOUR	If you have had anal sex with a new partner or with multiple partners in the past three months.
MEDICATIONS	→ Make sure to know the name of your medications.
SORE THROAT	Until symptoms disappear and, if you take antibiotics, until the antibiotic treatment is finished.
TICK BITE	If the tick bite occured less than 30 days ago.
VACCINATION	If you have been vaccinated against influenza (or flu) or COVID-19. OTHER VACCINES: consult with Héma-Québec staff.
WEIGHT.	 Whole blood donation: For MEN, you can give blood if your weight is at least 50 kg (110 lb).

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• For WOMEN, if you are aged 23 or over, you can give blood if your weight is at least 50 kg (110 lb). If you are between the ages of 18 and 22, consult with Héma-Québec staff to find out if you can give blood.

VISITED COUNTRIES

CAN I GIVE BLOOD?

RISK FOR ZIKA AND OTHER ARBOVIRUS

If, during the past 21 days, you have returned from a trip to someplace other than **CANADA**, the continental **UNITED STATES** or **EUROPE**, you cannot give blood for three weeks (21 days) following the date on which you returned.

RISK FOR MALARIA*		
BAHAMAS	Country not at risk for malaria.	
COSTA RICA	If you visited the provinces of Alajuela or Limón: temporary exclusion**. If you visited any other region in Costa Rica.	
CUBA	Country not at risk for malaria.	
DOMINICAN REPUBLIC	If you visited the provinces of Santo Domingo, San Cristobal, San Juan or La Altagracia (including Punta Cana), or any other province on the border with Haiti (Dajabón, Elías Piña, Independancia, Monte Cristi, Pedernales): temporary exclusion**.	
	If you visited any other region in Dominican Republic.	
GUATEMALA	If you visited the cities of Antigua, Guatemala and Atitlan Lake.	
OOM EMMEN	If you visited any other region in Guatemala: temporary exclusion**.	
HAITI	Temporary exclusion**.	
JAMAICA	Country not at risk for malaria.	
MEWIOO	If you visited the province of Chiapas or Chihuahua: temporary exclusion**.	
MEXICO	If you visited any other region in Mexico.	
NICARAGUA	If you visited the autonomous regions of North Caribbean Coast or South Caribbean Coast: temporary exclusion**.	
	If you visited any other region in Nicaragua.	
VENEZUELA	Temporary exclusion**.	

^{*} The malaria criterion does not apply to apheresis plasma donations intended for manufacturing solutions based on plasma proteins.





^{**} IF YOU STAYED LESS THAN 6 MONTHS: 3 months after your return date. IF YOU STAYED 6 MONTHS AND MORE: 3 years after your return date.
